Additional Uniform Items - all year groups

Senior School Shirt - Unisex	White long-sleeved shirt, tucked in with top button fastened. Pupils can wear short sleeved shirt in Summer Term.
Shoes - Unisex	Formal, black and plain in design. Low heel only. No trainer styles and no logos. If pupils are found to be wearing trainers or a non-regulation sports brand of shoe without a medical note they will be asked to replace shoes as soon as possible.
Socks - Unisex	Mid-grey and plain in design. Long socks are not permitted when wearing shorts.
Tights	Black or flesh coloured.

Uniform Rules and Guidance

Hair	Hair must be kept clean, neat and tidy. Hair should be natural in colour and not visibly dyed or bleached. Expect to be challenged on excessively short hair or extreme hairstyles which will be deemed unacceptable. Students must be clean shaven across all age groups.
Headwear	Headwear may not be worn, unless for religious observance and must be either navy blue, black or dark green
Jewellery	Jewellery is limited to a watch, single pair of metal, plain studs earrings, worn in the earlobe. In the Sixth Form students may wear two pairs of earrings with hoops no bigger than 1.5cm, a ring, single necklace, and single bracelet.



Make-up	No make-up is allowed before the 4th year. When worn it must be discrete and subtle. Acrylic nails, coloured nail varnish and false eyelashes must not be worn for school. Clear shades of nail varnish are permitted.
Outer coats/Blazers	Coats may be worn to and from school and must be a dark colour and plain in style. Coats are not permitted in the school buildings and in the absence of a blazer. No hoodies are permitted. Blazers must be worn in the Michaelmas and Lent Terms and for events such as Prizegiving and Cathedral. Blazers do not have to be worn in the Summer Term.
Tattoos	It is illegal to get a tattoo until the age of 18.

Expectations and Sanctions

It is our expectation that every student is neatly turned out in clean, full, school uniform and always follow the uniform code. In cases of repeated non-compliance parents will be contacted, replacements sought and students may be sent home.
